AN ACT concerning

Personnel Law - County Holidays

For the purpose of eliminating the day after Thanksgiving as a County holiday and providing that employees shall be given four hours of personal leave each year to compensate for the loss of General Election Day as a County holiday.

BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

SUBTITLE 16. PERSONNEL.

Section 16-219,

The Prince George's County Code

(1995 Edition, as amended by CB-4-1996).

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that Section 16-219 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

SUBTITLE 16. PERSONNEL.

DIVISION 17. LEAVE.

Sec. 16-219. Holiday leave.

(a) Regular Holidays. The following days shall be regular holidays for employees:

- (1) New Year's Day;
- (2) Martin Luther King's Birthday;
- (3) Presidential Inauguration Day;

- (4) Washington's Birthday;
- (5) Memorial Day;
- (6) Independence Day;
- (7) Labor Day;
- (8) Columbus Day;
- (9) Veteran's Day;
- (10) Thanksgiving Day; [and the following Friday;]
- (11) County Employee's Appreciation Day; and
- (12) Christmas Day.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that all eligible employees shall be given an additional four (4) hours of personal leave per year, or the appropriate proportionate amount for part-time employees, in lieu of General Election Day being a regular County holiday. Employees shall be entitled to utilize such additional personal leave granted in leave year 1996 during leave year 1997.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that in the event this Act does not take effect prior to November 29, 1996, that date shall be observed as a County Employee Appreciation Day for 1996, in accordance with the provisions of Executive Order 40-1995.

SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
