RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Neighborhood and Community Assistance Program Projects

3 For the purpose of naming a designee to submit a letter of approval on behalf of Prince George's
4 County to the Department of Housing and Community Development of the State of Maryland for
5 Neighborhood and Community Assistance Program Projects.

6 WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Community Development of the State of
7 Maryland (the "Department") has established the Neighborhood Business Development Program
8 (the "Program") pursuant to Article 83B, Sections 4-201 through 4-208 of the Maryland
9 Annotated Code, as amended, for purposes of providing financial assistance to projects that have
10 received the support of the local jurisdiction in which the project is located; and

11 WHEREAS, Article 83B, Section 4-204 of the Maryland Annotated Code, allows an
12 authorized designee of the County to inform the Program of the County's support for a project.

13 WHEREAS, Prince George's County desires to designate the County Executive as the
14 person authorized by the County to inform the Program, by letter, that the County supports the
15 Neighborhood Business Development Program project.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
17 County, Maryland, that the County Executive is authorized by the County to inform the
18 Department, by letter, that Prince George's County approves the Neighborhood and Community
19 Assistance Program project.

20 This designation is effective as of the 3rd day of February, 1998 and shall remain in effect until a
21 new designee is appointed by resolution of this body.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this County Executive shall provide a list of approved
2 applicants to the Council at least 7 days prior to the submission of the County's recommendations
3 to the Department, and at least 14 days prior to the application deadline established by the
4 Department.
