County to the Department of Housing and Community Development of the State of Maryland for		
Neighborhood an	d Community Assistance Program Projects.	
WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Community Development of the State of		
Maryland (the "Department") has established the Neighborhood Business Development Program		
(the "Program") pursuant to Article 83B, Sections 4-201 through 4-208 of the Maryland		
Annotated Code, as amended, for purposes of providing financial assistance to projects that have		
received the support of the local jurisdiction in which the project is located; and		
WHEREAS, Article 83B, Section 4-204 of the Maryland Annotated Code, allows an		
authorized designee of the County to inform the Program of the County's support for a project.		
WHEREAS, Prince George's County desires to designate the County Executive as the		
person authorized by the County to inform the Program, by letter, that the County supports the		
Neighborhood Business Development Program project.		
NOW, THE	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's	
County, Maryland, that the County Executive is authorized by the County to inform the		
Department, by letter, that Prince George's County approves the Neighborhood and Community		
Assistance Progra	am project.	
This designation is effective as of the 3rd day of February, 1998 and shall remain in effect until a		
new designee is appointed by resolution of this body.		

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this County Executive shall provide a list of approved applicants to the Council at least 7 days prior to the submission of the County's recommendations to the Department, and at least 14 days prior to the application deadline established by the Department.
