Darryl Jones, President of Fraternal Order of Police Lodge #89 and Ken Nickels from the Labor Relations Department presented highlights of the Collective Bargaining Agreement.

Some highlights of the modified pay plan (Uniform Wage Scale) are:

1. A 4% increase in the base hourly rate retroactive to July 2 1989.

- 2. A 5.14% COL increase in the base hourly rate which is indexed to the CPI effective July 1, 1990.
- 3. A 7% COL increase in the base hourly rate effective July 14, 1991.
- 4. A new pay scale in the agreement is described in detail in Attachment A which is retroactive to July 2, 1989.

The fiscal impact on the County as a result of adopting this legislation is estimated to be \$17,168,006 for three years.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT (includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)

Prince George's County and the Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge #89 have completed labor negotiations on a new three year Labor Agreement covering Fiscal Years 1990 through 1992. This Emergency Bill is to adopt and approve the collective bargaining agreement in accordance with Section 16-233(f) of the Personnel Law.

The fiscal impact will be provided by the Office of Management and Budget.
