**BILL**

1 AN ACT concerning

2 The Classification Plan for Prince George's County

3 For the purpose of abolishing existing classes of work, changing titles for certain classes of work  
 4 and changing the grade of an existing class of work.

5 WHEREAS, the County Executive, pursuant to Section 903 of the Prince George's County  
 6 Charter and Section 16-125(a) of Subtitle 16 of the Prince George's County Code, has, in order  
 7 to provide better governmental services, recommended to the County Council amendments to the  
 8 Classification Plan for Prince George's County, Maryland, with respect to certain classes of work  
 9 described within Section 1 of this Bill; now, therefore,
