WHEREAS, Title 9, Subtitle 5 of the Environment Article of the Annotated Code of	
Maryland requires the County to adopt a comprehensive plan dealing with water supply and	
sewerage systems, established the procedures governing the preparation and adoption of said	
plan, and provide	s for amendments and revisions thereto; and
WHEREAS, pursuant to said procedures, the County Executive submitted to the County	
Council her recommendations on water and sewer plan amendment requests within the June	
2025 Cycle of An	nendments; and
WHEREAS, the County Council received testimony through an advertised public hearing	
on the June 2025	Cycle of Amendments; and
WHEREAS	, the County Council notified the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission,
The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission, The State and County Health	
Departments, the Maryland Department of Planning and the Maryland Department of the	
Environment of the public hearing and provided each agency with copies of the June 2025 Cycle	
of Amendments.*	
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's	
County, Maryland, that the Prince George's County 2018 Water and Sewer Plan, as adopted by	
CR-64-2019, and amended by CR-75-2019, CR-11-2020, CR-45-2020, CR-87-2020, CR-98-	

2020, CR-22-2021, CR-49-2021, CR-87-2021, CR-105-2021, CR-017-2022, CR-063-2022, CR-

097-2022, CR-014-2023, CR-076-2023, CR,023-2024, CR-064-2024, CR-037-2025 and CR-1 2 053-2025 is further amended by adding the water and sewer category designations as shown in 3 Attachment A and Attachment B, attached hereto and made a part hereof.\* 4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that maps identified as the "Prince George's County, 5 Maryland, 2018 Water Map" and "Prince George's County, Maryland, 2018 Sewer Map," are 6 hereby amended to incorporate the approved category changes with the property location 7 delineated on the map in Attachment B, attached hereto and made a part hereof. 8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that within five working days of the adoption of this 9 Resolution, it shall be transmitted to the County Executive by the Clerk of the Council. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect on the day following 10 11 the first regularly scheduled Council meeting day which occurs after the County Executive 12 indicates she has no comments, or ten working days following the transmittal of this Resolution 13 to the County Executive, whichever shall occur first.
