RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

Student Service Learning

For the purpose of requesting the County Executive to designate a Student Service Learning coordinator to identify direct service learning opportunities in each County agency and to compile and promulgate a directory of direct service learning activities available in the County.

WHEREAS, the Maryland State Department of Education has issued high school graduation requirements that require each student to complete 75 hours of student service that includes preparation, action, and reflection components; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of Prince George's County has implemented a student service learning program which consists of a curriculum infusion component for grades 7, 8, and 9 and a direct service requirement of 36 hours to be completed between grades 7 through 12; and

WHEREAS, the County provides a number of direct services to qualified individuals and to the public at large which would be suitable for satisfying the 36 hour direct service requirement; and

WHEREAS, each County agency and department can expand its delivery of public and individual services through the use of volunteers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the County Executive is requested to designate a Student Service Learning coordinator to identify direct service learning opportunities in each County agency

and department that will satisfy the direct service learning graduation requirement for public high schools in Prince George's County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Executive is requested to compile and promulgate a directory of direct service learning activities available in the County no later than February 1, 1997.
