<u>CR-71-2009</u> - WSSC Refunding Of Bonds AN ACT for the purpose of approving the Refunding Plan of the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission for the refunding of certain bonds of Washington Suburban Sanitary District through the issuance of General Construction Refunding Bonds, Water Supply Refunding Bonds, and Sewage Disposal Refunding Bonds of Washington Suburban Sanitary District.

<u>CB-40-2009</u> (Council Members Exum, Dernoga and Knotts) AN ACT for the purpose of amending provisions of the Code relating to towing regulations and towing of vehicles from private property, establishing license fees and penalties, and transferring certain responsibilities regarding towing regulations from the Police Department to the Department of Environmental Resources.

<u>CB-35-2009</u> (Council Member Knotts) AN ACT concerning Rental Housing For the purpose of amending provisions of the County Code relating to rental housing license suspension or revocation, requiring a landlord to begin eviction proceedings against a tenant that has received a certain number of disruptive conduct reports from the Police Department, defining disruptive conduct, and generally relating to rental housing.

<u>CB-44-2009</u> (Council Member Exum) AN ACT concerning Roads and Sidewalks For the purpose of clarifying that the placement of portable storage containers in road rights-of-way is prohibited.
