Committee Vote: Favorable, 5-0 (In favor: Councilmember's Exum, Knotts, Bland, Campos and Turner.

This bill will amend the tax credit for real property for residential homeowners who utilize solar energy conservation devices by including clarifying language of "generating of electricity" to be used in the structure for solar energy device.

The Office of Law has reviewed this bill and finds it to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to the enactment.

The enactment of CB-5-2009 will not have a negative fiscal impact on the county.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

In 2008 the County Council adopted CB-11-2008 establishing real property tax credit for residential buildings who utilize solar or geothermal energy conservation devices using alternative energy sources. This bill seeks a clarification from the Office of Finance under the State Tax Property Article.
