## **REPORT:**

Committee Vote: Favorable, 7-0 (In Favor: Council Members Davis, Glaros, Harrison, Patterson, Taveras, Toles and Turner)

CB-20-2016 as proposed is an act concerning the Prince George's County Police Pension Plan. The legislation will amend the Prince George's County Police Pension Plan to change the normal retirement date for newly hired officers from 20 years to 25 years of service. The bill will also provide for a monthly benefit of \$1000.00 for the surviving spouse of those officers killed in the line of duty.

During deliberations on the bill, it was pointed out by the Executive's Office that the Fraternal Order of Police (FOP), Lodge 89, Inc. supports the bill. It was also stated that the bill will provide long term cost savings to the County.

The Office of Law reports the bill to be in proper legal form with no impediments to its enactment.

After deliberation, the bill was reported out of the Committee of the Whole 7-0 favorable.
