Committee Vote: Favorable, 3-0 (Council Members Wilson, Gourdine and Maloney).

Staff gave an overview of the legislation and informed the Committee of comments that were received. The Executive Branch supports the resolution. The Office of Audits and Investigations finds that there should be no negative fiscal impact on the County as a result of adopting CR-71-1998.

This legislation will approve a Live Near Your Work (LNYW) Grant Program within Prince George's County in cooperation with local employers and the Department of Housing and Community Development of the State of Maryland, and authorizes the Prince George's County Economic Development Corporation to operate the program and fund the County's share (which is expected to range between \$10,000 and \$25,000 per year). The LNYW Program will provide a minimum \$3,000 cash grant to employees for down payment or closing cost assistance to purchase homes in targeted neighborhoods near their employers. The LNYW boundaries are shown on Attachment A.

A representative of the Prince George's County Economic Development Corporation (EDC) indicated that this program will support the retention and attraction of companies who have expressed their concern about retaining quality employees that currently live outside of the County, and may otherwise have to commute a great distance to work. Currently two employers are willing to participate in the Program.

A representative from the County Executive's Office indicated that the \$3,000 is matched funds. The State will contribute \$1,000 per employee, which will be matched by both the local jurisdiction and the participating employer.

This legislation will approve a Live Near Your Work Grant Program within Prince George's County in cooperation with local employers and the Department of Housing and Community Development of the State of Maryland, and authorizes the Prince George's County Economic Development Corporation to operate the program.
