BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Individuals Not Eligible for County Employment

3 For the purpose of prohibiting certain individuals employed by certain federal agencies from
4 County employment; and generally relating to County personnel.

5 BY adding:

6 SUBTITLE 16. PERSONNEL.

7 Section 16-150.01,

8 The Prince George's County Code

9 (2023 Edition; 2025 Supplement).

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
11 Maryland, that Section 16-150.01 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby
12 added:

13 SUBTITLE 16. PERSONNEL.

14 DIVISION 5. METHODS OF FILLING POSITIONS.

15 **Sec. 16-150.01. Certain individuals not eligible for County employment.**

16 (a) No appointing authority shall fill or request to fill any vacant position in the classified
17 service or the exempt service within the Police Department, Office of the Sheriff, or Department
18 of Corrections with a candidate who was employed as a sworn officer or served in a direct
19 administrative support role for sworn officers in the following federal agencies, unless their
20 employment terminated prior to October 1, 2025:

21 (1) United States Customs and Border Protection; and

(2) United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement.


(b) This section applies prospectively only and does not apply to any individual who is a County employee prior to the effective date of this Section.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection, or section.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
