The Public Facilities Element of the Preliminary Bowie State MARC Station Sector Plan and						
Proposed Sectional Map Amendment						
For the purpose of identifying inconsistencies between the Preliminary Bowie State MARC						
Station Sector Plan and Proposed Sectional Map Amendment and existing or proposed State or						
County facilities, and approving the inclusion of any new transportation proposals prior to the						
adopting of the sector plan by the Planning Board.						
WHEREAS, Section 27-645 of the Zoning Ordinance for Prince George's County,						
Maryland, requires the Prince George's Planning Board of the Maryland-National Capital Park						
and Planning Commission to submit its proposals for public facilities in the Plan to the District						
Council and to the County Executive prior to adoption by the Planning Board; and						
WHEREAS, the Zoning Ordinance also provides a review period for the County Executive						
and the District Council to review, provide written comments, and identify any inconsistencies						
between the public facilities proposed in the Plan and any existing or proposed State or County						
facilities including roads, highways, or other public facilities; and						
WHEREAS, Se	ection 27-645 provides that the adopted plan may not include a highway or					
transportation line unless the District Council, after consultation with the County Executive,						
approves (by resolution) the inclusion of the highway or transportation line for planning						
purposes; and						
WHEREAS, on May 28, 2009, the Planning Board transmitted the public facilities

71B) for public facility inconsistencies review and for approval of the inclusion of proposed highways and transportation lines for planning purposes attached hereto as Attachment A; and

WHEREAS, on September 22, 2009 the District Council held a session to review the public facilities element of the Preliminary Bowie State MARC Station Sector Plan and evaluated comments on proposed transportation facilities provided by the Maryland-State Highway Administration, Maryland Transit Administration and the County Department of Public Works and Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the District Council has concluded that, in general, the new and modified public facility transportation proposals contained in the Preliminary Bowie State MARC Station Sector Plan are consistent with the County's Capital Improvement Program (CIP) and the State's Consolidated Transportation Program (CTP). The District Council also recognizes that the sector plan is long range and some of the proposals go beyond the five-year to six-year time frame of the CTP and CIP; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, that the transportation system and public facilities proposals proposed in the public facilities element for the Preliminary Bowie State MARC Station Sector Plan, as transmitted on May 28, 2009, by the Prince George's County Planning Board, are hereby approved for the purpose of the inclusion of the proposed new transportation lines and public facilities in the adopted plan; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council intends to further review the plan and its public facilities element following the joint public hearing and receipt of the adopted plan from the Planning Board, and may at that time revise the plan and its transportation system if changes appear justifiable and consistent with long-range goals and objectives; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Chairman of the Prince George's County Planning Board.
