BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

OpenDoor Housing Fund, formerly Washington Area Housing Trust Fund, has proposed a Neighborhood Intervention Plan and Project and is requesting funding in the amount of \$500,000 from the State of Maryland's Community Legacy Program. The Community Legacy funding will allow OpenDoor to provide financial assistance to community development organizations to finance the predevelopment and acquisition of affordable housing projects in priority funding areas in Prince George's County, thereby contributing to the reinvestment and revitalization of the area. The State of Maryland requires local legislative support for each Community Legacy Program application in unincorporated areas.
