(a) The Planning Board shall require that proposed subdivisions conform to the following:

(5) The preliminary plan and final plat shall conform to the area master plan,							
including maps and text, unless the Planning Board finds that events have occurred to render the							
relevant plan recommendations no longer appropriate or the District Council has not imposed the							
recommended zoning. Notwithstanding any other requirement of this Section, a proposed							
preliminary plan or final plat of subdivision may be designed to conform with the land use policy							
recommendations for centers, as approved within the current County general plan, unless the							
District Council has not imposed the recommended zoning.							
SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take on the date that it							
becomes law.
