1 AN ACT concerning

2 Amendment of Section 815, Charter of Prince George's County

3 For the purpose of proposing an amendment to Section 815 of the Charter of Prince George's
4 County to provide that approved staffing complements may not be increased without prior
5 approval of the County Council.

6 BY proposing an amendment to:

7 Section 815,

8 Charter of Prince George's County, Maryland.

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
10 Maryland, that the following amendment to Section 815, Charter of Prince George's County,
11 Maryland, is hereby proposed:

12 Section 815. Supplementary Appropriations; Staffing Level Increases.

13 (a) During any fiscal year, the Council, upon recommendation of the County Executive,
14 may, by resolution, make additional or supplementary appropriations from unexpended and
15 unencumbered funds set aside for contingencies in the County budget, and from federal, state or
16 private grants which were not included in the budget for the current fiscal year, and may, by
17 Legislative Act, make additional or supplementary appropriations from revenue received from
18 anticipated sources but in excess of budget estimates therefor, from revenues received from
19 sources not anticipated in the budget for the current fiscal year and from any prior year available
20 and uncommitted fund balance.

(b) During any fiscal year, no agency of County government may exceed the number of positions in each grade for that agency as approved in the operating budget without the prior approval of the Council.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that a copy of this Act be transmitted to the County Executive for publication and that a copy also be transmitted to the Board of Supervisors of Elections for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters of this County at the 2006 General Election pursuant to Section 1105 of the Charter.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the question of adoption of this proposed Charter Amendment shall be submitted to the voters of the County at the General Election occurring on November 7, 2006, and shall be placed on the ballot in the following form:

PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT

To provide that the staffing level of any agency approved in the annual operating budget may not be increased without prior approval of the Council.

Adopted this 10th day of August, 2006, by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of the full County Council.
