SECTION 1. BE IT EN	ACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
Maryland, that the following a	amendment to Section 815, Charter of Prince George's County,
Maryland, is hereby proposed	:
Section 815. Supplementary	Appropriations; Staffing Level Increases.
(a) During any fiscal year, the Council, upon recommendation of the County Executive,	
may, by resolution, make additional or supplementary appropriations from unexpended and	
unencumbered funds set aside	for contingencies in the County budget, and from federal, state or
private grants which were not	included in the budget for the current fiscal year, and may, by
Legislative Act, make addition	nal or supplementary appropriations from revenue received from
anticipated sources but in excess of budget estimates therefor, from revenues received from	
sources not anticipated in the	budget for the current fiscal year and from any prior year available

and uncommitted fund balance.

1 (b) During any fiscal year, no agency of County government may exceed the number of 2 positions in each grade for that agency as approved in the operating budget without the prior 3 approval of the Council. SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that a copy of this Act be transmitted to the 4 5 County Executive for publication and that a copy also be transmitted to the Board of Supervisors 6 of Elections for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters of this County at the 2006 7 General Election pursuant to Section 1105 of the Charter. 8 SECTION 3.
