BILL

AN ACT concerning

Land Acquisition for Maryland-National
Capital Park and Planning Commission

For the purpose of authorizing The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission to acquire a parcel of land consisting of .086 acres more or less with improvements from the Department of Veteran Affairs, for public use purposes.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that pursuant to the authority contained in Section 7-106 of Article 28 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission is hereby authorized to acquire with monies from the Advance Land Acquisition Fund, a certain parcel consisting of approximately .086 acres more or less with improvements owned by the Department of Veteran Affairs, being described as Liber 08443, Folio 789; Tax Map 050, Grid A-2, situated in Prince George's County, Maryland, Election District 17, consisting of the north 75 feet of Lots 15 and 16 (subject to land survey), Block C, Brentwood Holladay Company's Addition to Highlands, Platbook A@9, with a total area of 3,750 square feet improved, generally located on the corner lot at 4501 Church Street, North Brentwood, for public use.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the Clerk of the Council is hereby directed to transmit a copy of this Act to The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
