RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

Compensation of the Chairman of the Prince George's County Planning Board For the purpose of establishing and providing for the compensation of the Chairman of the Prince George's County Planning Board.

WHEREAS, Article 28, Section 2-104 of the Annotated Code of Maryland governs the compensation of members of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, upon recommendation from the County Executive, the County Council may authorize whatever supplementary compensation as may be deemed appropriate for the Chairman of the Prince George's County Planning Board, designated to serve on a full-time basis; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended the compensation for that position; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the salary for the full-time Chairman of the Prince George's County Planning Board be and the same is hereby continued at the maximum rate for Grade G-38 in the General Schedule of the Prince George's County Salary Plan as it may be adjusted from time to time, with additional compensation in the amount of \$10,000 for the first year of this term only.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, in addition to salary, the full-time Chairman of the Prince George's County Planning Board shall be entitled to the fringe benefits for full-time employees of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission and shall accrue annual leave on the basis of thirty (30) days per year.
