## PUBLIC SAFETY AND FISCAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT 10/1/98

Committee Vote: Favorable as amended, 3-0, (In favor: Council Members Estepp, Scott and Wilson)

This bill will establish a Treatment Access Commission which shall determine the scope and objectives for a pre-trial diversionary program, develop recommendations and policies for the operation of the program and prepare an annual report of its activities to be presented to the County Executive and the County Council.

The State's Attorney's Office, the Health Department and the Maryland Division of Parole and

Probation supports the legislation.

The Administrative Judge of the Circuit Court expressed concerns with Section 7-200 and Section 7-201-(d).

The Department of Corrections suggested that this Commission could better function as an ad hoc under the auspices of the Intermediate Sanctions Policy Board (ISPB).

The Committee voted to amend this legislation by incorporating the composition and responsibilities of the proposed Treatment Access Commission within the Intermediate Sanctions Policy Board.

There should not be any negative fiscal impact on the County as a result of enacting CB-102-1998.
