### REPORT:

Committee Vote: Favorable, 11-0 (In favor: Council Members Hawkins, Anderson-Walker, Davis, Dernoga, Franklin, Glaros, Harrison, Ivey, Streeter, Taveras and Turner)

The County Council, sitting as the Committee of the Whole, convened on June 24, 2021 to consider CR-75-2021. The Planning, Housing and Economic Development Committee Director summarized the purpose of the resolution. CR-75-2021 amends the approved Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission (M-NCPPC) Operating Budget for the Recreation Fund to correct a clerical error in project charge allocations. This Resolution provides for the transfer of \$20,000 from the Anacostia Watershed Society, Inc. (AWS) to the Anacostia Trails Heritage Area, Inc. (ATHA). No increase in overall expenditures will result from adoption of the modification to the approved FY 2021-22 budget.

The Office of Law reviewed CR-75-2021 as it was introduced on June 22, 2021 and finds it to be in proper legislative form. The Office of Law sees no legal impediments to its adoption.

Terry Bell, County Executive's Liaison to the County Council, indicated that the County Executive is in support of the legislation.

On a motion by Council Member Turner and second by Council Member Streeter, the Committee of the Whole voted favorable on CR-75-2021 as drafted.
