1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 FY 2002-2011 Comprehensive Ten Year Solid Waste Management Plan

3 For the purpose of adopting the Prince George's County FY 2002-2011 Ten Year Solid Waste
4 Management Plan as recommended by the County Executive.

5 WHEREAS, Title 9, Subtitle 5 of the Environment Article of the Annotated Code of
6 Maryland requires the County to adopt and submit to the Maryland Department of the
7 Environment a comprehensive Plan dealing with solid waste disposal systems, and solid waste
8 acceptance facilities; and

9 WHEREAS, said Code establishes procedures governing the preparation and adoption of
10 said Plan, and provides for amendments and revisions thereto; and

11 WHEREAS, pursuant to said procedures, the County Executive submitted to the County
12 Council a proposed FY 2002-2011 Comprehensive Ten Year Solid Waste Management Plan to
13 update the 1998 Comprehensive Ten Year Solid Waste Plan; and

14 WHEREAS, the County Council received testimony through an advertised public hearing;
15 and

16 WHEREAS, the County Council notified the municipalities, the Washington Suburban
17 Sanitary Commission, the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission, the State
18 and County Health Departments, the Maryland Office of Planning and the Maryland Department
19 of the Environment of the public hearings and provided each agency with copies of the proposed
20 Plan.

21 SECTION 1. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince
22 George's County, Maryland, that the document titled "Proposed " is hereby adopted as the Prince

1 George's County FY 2002-2011 Comprehensive Ten Year Solid Waste Management Plan.

2 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the adopted Prince George's County
3 1998 Ten Year Solid Waste Plan is repealed and superseded.

4 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that within five (5) working days of the
5 adoption of this resolution, it shall be transmitted to the County Executive by the Clerk of the
6 Council.

7 SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
8 County, Maryland, that this resolution shall take effect on the day following the first regularly
9 scheduled Council meeting day which occurs after the County Executive transmits his comments
10 on this resolution, or on the day that the County Executive indicates he has no comments, or ten
11 (10) working days following transmittal of this resolution to the County Executive, whichever
12 shall occur first. Prior to the effective date of this resolution, the Council may reconsider its
13 action based upon any recommendation received from the County Executive.

14 SECTION 5. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the effective date of this resolution,
15 it shall be transmitted by the Clerk of the Council to the Secretary of the Maryland Department
16 of the Environment.
