This joint public hearing convened at 6:02 p.m. with seven Council Members present along with Peter Shapiro, Chair, Dorothy F. Bailey, Vice Chair, Shaunise Washington, Member, William M. Doerner, Member, and Manuel Geraldo, Member, Prince George's County Planning Board, Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission. Council Member Blegay arrived at 6:07 p.m. Tom Gross, Planning Supervisor, Historic Preservation Section, provided a brief overview and introduced Daniel Tana, staff, M-NCPPC, who facilitated a PowerPoint presentation titled "Evaluation for Historic Site Designation Yates and Mary Boswell House

6500 40th Avenue, University Park". The presentation highlighted the following: Southeast corner and front elevation, April 2023; Southeast corner; Partial north elevation showing fenestration of the main block; 6500 40th Avenue, University Park; Partial north elevation; Partial north elevation and northwest corner; West (rear) elevation; Boswell House partial south elevation; 6500 40th Avenue, University Park; Section 5A, Blocks 17, 20, 21; Washington Post photo of recently completed house, May 21, 1939; Yates P. Boswell Sr.'s 1942 draft card, showing the Boswell House address; Conclusions; and Recommendations. Darragh McNally and Emily McNally signed up to speak. All persons wishing to speak having done so this public hearing was declared held. The meeting concluded at 6:23 p.m.
