WHEREAS	, the current master plan and Sectional Map Amendment (SMA) for
Bladensburg – N	ew Carrollton and Vicinity (Planning Area 69) was approved in May 1994; and
WHEREAS	, Sections 27-225.01.05 and 27-641 of the Zoning Ordinance of Prince
George's County	establish procedures whereby the Prince George's County Planning Board may
initiate a Sector I	Plan and a concurrent SMA with the approval or concurrence of the District
Council; and	
WHEREAS	, the approved Fiscal Year 2010 Planning Department Work Program includes
the preparation o	f the Central Annapolis Road Sector Plan and SMA to evaluate the land uses,
plan elements, an	nd recommendations contained in the 1994 Approved Master Plan and Sectional
Map Amendment	for Bladensburg - New Carrollton and Vicinity (Planning Area 69), and to
implement the 20	002 General Plan's recommendations for tiers, growth centers, and designated

 corridor nodes within these planning areas, and the 2005 Countywide Green Infrastructure Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Sector Plan area is primarily focused on properties fronting on or within one quarter mile of Central Annapolis Road, and includes land bounded by the rear property line of Capital Plaza (6100 and 6200 Annapolis Road), Webster Street, Fairlawn Elementary School (southern boundary), Glenoak Road, Greendale Parkway, 71st Avenue, Marywood Street, Gallatin Street, Glenridge Shopping Center (7520 Annapolis Road, rear property line), Veterans Parkway (MD 410), Chesapeake Road, Buchanan Street, 72nd Avenue, Allison Street, 68th Avenue, the 6600 through 6800 Blocks of Annapolis Road (rear property lines), Cooper Lane, the 6400 and 6500 Blocks of Annapolis Road (rear property lines), 64th Avenue, Columbia Avenue (paper street), 62nd Avenue, Quincy Street (paper street), and Baltimore-Washington Parkway (MD 295) as shown in the attached Sector Plan boundary map; and

WHEREAS, the goals, concepts, guidelines, and public participation program (Attachment A) establish the purpose, the preliminary range of issues to be addressed during the plan preparation, and basic methodology for ensuring adequate community involvement throughout the planning process; and

WHEREAS, the Sector Plan will set development policies and guidelines to provide a mix of uses at an intensity appropriate for land within the Developed Tier, as articulated in the 2002 *Approved Prince George's County General Plan*; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the District Council to process the Sector Plan and Sectional Map Amendment concurrently, in accordance with Section 27-225.01.05 of the Zoning Ordinance, to shorten the process and provide a strong interrelationship between the Sector Plan and zoning of land as a tool to implement land use recommendations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission is hereby directed to prepare a Sector Plan and concurrent Sectional Map Amendment (SMA) for Central Annapolis Road in accordance with the requirements of Parts 3 and 13 of the Zoning Ordinance for Prince George's County, Maryland.
