**REPORT:** Favorable 8-0: Council Members Hawkins, Anderson-Walker, Davis, Dernoga, Glaros, Ivey, Taveras and Turner. **Absent:** Franklin, Harrison and Streeter

The Prince George's County Council convened as the Committee of the Whole on June 3, 2021, to consider CB-031-2021. As proposed, CB-031-2021 will amend the approved FY' 21 Capital Improvement Program budget for three projects including the medical unit at the Department of Corrections (\$6,485,000), Suitland Manor (\$6,000,000) and Systemic Replacements (\$4,819,000). The Systemic Replacement funds are from the State. The project descriptions are listed in Attachments A-C of the Bill. These funds are necessary for project continuance and completion. The total of funds transferred is \$17,304,000.

Stanley Earley, Director, Office of Management and Budget, provided the Committee an overview of CB-031-2021.

The Office of Law reports CB-031-2021 to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its enactment.

The Policy Analyst Group has submitted a detailed fiscal impact statement which is included.

After discussion, the Prince George's County Council, sitting as the Committee of the Whole, voted CB-031-2021 out favorably, 8-0.
