BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

This is companion legislation to the bill to approve the collective bargaining agreement between Prince George's County, Maryland and the International Association of Fire Fighters, Local 1619, AFL-CIO (Fire Fighters, Paramedics and Fire Fighter/Medics) for Fiscal Years 2019 and 2020. This resolution also reflects modifications to the agreement. A fiscal impact statement will be provided by the Office of Management and Budget.

The proposed salary plan amendments were submitted to the County Council by the County Executive on July 27, 2018. Pursuant to Section 903 of the Charter, if the Council fails to take final action on the proposed salary plan before September 25, 2018 the salary plan shall stand approved.
