RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Housing and Community Development

3 Annual Action Plan: FY 2009, as amended

4 For the purpose of amending the Prince George's County "Annual Action Plan: FY 2009" to
5 serve as the application for a Community Development Block Grant Recovery Program grant.

6 WHEREAS, Title XII of Division A of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of
7 2009, Pub. L. No. 111-5, 123 Stat. 115, 217 (2009) (hereinafter "Title XII of the Recovery Act"),
8 appropriated \$1 billion for Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") funds; and

9 WHEREAS, the program established under Title XII of the Recovery Act is commonly
10 referred to as the CDBG Recovery ("CDBG-R") program to carry out, on an expedited basis,
11 eligible CDBG program activities under Title I of the Housing and Community Development
12 Act of 1974 (42 U.S.C. 5301 *et seq.*); and

13 WHEREAS, the County has been allocated \$1,643,034 in CDBG-R funding; and

14 WHEREAS, in order to receive its allocation, the County is required by HUD Notice,
15 Docket No. FR-5309-N-01 (May 4, 2009), to submit by June 5, 2009, a CDBG-R substantial
16 amendment to the County's "Annual Action Plan: FY 2009," a draft copy of which is attached
17 hereto and incorporated herein as "The CDBG-R Substantial Amendment"; and

18 WHEREAS, the CDBG-R substantial amendment allows the Prince George's County
19 Department of Housing and Community Development to use \$1,643,034 in CDBG-R funds for
20 eligible activities described therein.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
22 County that "The CDBG-R Substantial Amendment," a copy of which shall be marked for

1 identification by the Clerk of the County Council and maintained as a permanent record, is
2 hereby approved.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Executive or his designee is hereby
4 authorized to submit "The CDBG-R Substantial Amendment" to the U.S. Department of
5 Housing and Community Development ("HUD"), to act as necessary in connection with the
6 submission, and to provide such additional information to HUD as may be required.
