AN ACT concerning

Burglar and Holdup Alarm User's License

FOR the purpose of providing for alarm user permits and renewals
thereof to be on a biennial basis.

BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

SUBTITLE 9. ELECTRICITY.

Section 9-134,

The Prince George's County Code

(1987 Edition, 1988 Supplement).

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the
County Council of Prince George
's County, Maryland, that Section 9-134 of the Prince George's
County Code be and the same is hereby repealed and reenacted with
the following amendments:

SUBTITLE 9. ELECTRICITY.

**DIVISION 3. BURGLAR AND HOLDUP ALARM USER'S LICENSE AND
REGISTRATION.**

Sec. 9-134. Alarm user permits.

* * * * *

(c) Alarm User Permit Fees.

(1) There shall be a [Fifteen Dollar (\$15.00)] Thirty Dollar (\$30.00) nonrefundable permit fee for the first two years.

(2) There shall be [an annual] a nonrefundable biennial renewal fee of [Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00)] Thirty Dollars (\$30.00).

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty five (45) calendar days after the date it becomes law.
