Fiscal Policy & Government Operations Committee Date: 7/15/92

Committee Vote: Favorable, 4-0-1 (In favor: Council Members Mills, Bell, Del Giudice and MacKinnon; Abstained: Council Member Wineland)

Highlight of Benefits:

1. 8.5% COLA 3/93-6/93.
2. No COLA in FY92.
3. Increased annual leave carryover to 130 days.
4. One-time clothing allowance increase of \$700 in FY93.
5. Physical conditioning supplement of \$175 for FY93.

The estimated savings for fiscal year 1992-93 is approximately \$39,919.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

The Council is considering for enactment, legislation which will implement the provisions of the recently renegotiated Collective Bargaining Agreement for the Correctional Officers through the rank of Sergeant. The proposed resolution will implement similar provisions for Correctional Officials from the rank of Lieutenant through the rank of Major. Charter Section 903 and Personnel Law Section 16- 125(a) require Council action to amend Salary Plan.
