Committee Vote: Favorable, 4-0 (In favor: Council Members Turner, Taveras, Patterson and Davis)

CR-27-2016 concerns the STATEWIDE SPECIAL TRANSPORTATION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM for the purpose of authorizing the Director of the Prince George's County Department of Public Works and Transportation to file an application for Fiscal Year 2017 with the Maryland Transit Administration of the Maryland Department of Transportation for certain grants under the Statewide Special Transportation Assistance Program ("SSTAP") and the Federal Transit Act.

Staff oriented the Committee on this legislation including the referral comments. Martin Harris of the Prince George's County Department of Public Works and Transportation provided comments and answered questions by the members of the Committee regarding CR-27-2016.

The Office of Law finds that CR-27-2016 is in proper legislative form and there are no legal impediments to its adoption.

The Office of Audits & Investigations found that enactment of CR-27-2016 will have a negative or adverse fiscal impact in the amount of \$17,940 which is the County share of the project costs as it relates to this program. Should the State approve the application, the total grant award to the County will be \$350,759.
