RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning a
2 Countywide Green Infrastructure Functional Master Plan

3 For the purpose of initiating a Countywide Green Infrastructure Functional Master Plan, to
4 enhance and implement environmental policies in the 2002 General Plan.

5 WHEREAS, Section 27-641 of the Zoning Ordinance establishes procedures for the Prince
6 George’s County Planning Board to initiate a functional master plan, with the approval of the
7 District Council; and

8 WHEREAS, the Approved FY 2003 Planning Department Work Program requires the
9 preparation of a Countywide Green Infrastructure Functional Master Plan, to enhance and
10 implement the policies of the 2002 General Plan; and

11 WHEREAS, the District Council established Commission 2000, to prepare a Biennial
12 Growth Policy Plan, with the assistance of Planning Department staff; and

13 WHEREAS; Commission 2000 drafted and transmitted a Biennial Growth Policy Plan,
14 which the District Council approved in November, 2000, in CB-80-2000; and

15 WHEREAS, the Biennial Growth Policy Plan made recommendations concerning policies
16 for environmental preservation and enhancement; and

17 WHEREAS, pursuant to CB-97-2000, the Biennial Growth Policy Plan has served as the
18 Interim General Plan until a new, more comprehensive General Plan is prepared; and

19 WHEREAS, on July 25, 2002, the Planning Board asked the District Council to initiate the
20 Countywide Green Infrastructure Functional Master Plan; and

21 WHEREAS, on July 30, 2002, the District Council approved the General Plan in

2 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
3 County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington
4 Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Maryland-National Capital Park
5 and Planning Commission is hereby directed to prepare a Countywide Green Infrastructure
6 Functional Master Plan for Prince George's County, in accordance with Part 13 of the Zoning
7 Ordinance.
