LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

PLANNING AND ZONING COMMITTEE REPORT

Committee Vote: Favorable, 5-0 (In favor: Council Members Bell, Castaldi, Del Giudice, Fletcher and Mills).

Staff explained that this legislation is identical to CB-86-1991, which was reported out of committee with a favorable report on October 15, except that the use would be permitted in the O-S and R-A Zones on 9, rather than 10 contiguous acres. Anita Johnson, who owns a riding stable on 9.9 acres, spoke in support of the legislation.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

(Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)

Commercial riding stables are currently a permitted use in the R-R Zone on lots having a net area of over 20,000 square feet, but are only permitted by Special Exception in the O-S and R-A Zones. This legislation makes a riding stable a permitted use in these two zones, providing the property is at least nine acres in size.
