BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

(Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)

State enabling legislation authorizing the System Development Charge (SDC) fee provides that the two Councils shall meet annually to discuss and approve the SDC fee. The Councils met on May 9, 2002, and agreed to increase the SDC maximum allowable ceiling by a percentage equal to the Consumer Price Index for the prior calendar year. The CPI for November, 2000, to November 2001, increased by 2.1%. The Commission is not increasing the SDC fee. The fee remains the same for the fourth consecutive year. This action provides the Commission with the flexibility in future fiscal years to increase the base System Development Charge for water supply fixtures with an assigned fixture value of 1 from \$88.00 to a maximum of \$95.00, and the base System Development Charge for drainage fixture with an assigned drainage fixture unit

value of 1 from \$115.00 to a maximum of \$125.00.
