**LEGISLATIVE HISTORY**

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT**

Current Charter provisions provide for the filling of vacancies by special election during the first two years of a term and by appointment from a list of nominees provided by the appropriate party central committee during the last two years of a term. The proposed Charter amendment would provide for a vacancy to be filled by a special election to be called not less than thirty days nor more than ninety days after the vacancy occurs.
