ZONING BILL

AN ORDINANCE concerning

Historic Sites and Districts Plan

FOR the purpose of establishing that the Historic Preservation

Commission shall serve as the Citizens Advisory Committee during the amendment of the Historic Sites and Districts Plan.

BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

Section 27-642(c),

The Zoning Ordinance of Prince George's County, Maryland,

being also

SUBTITLE 27. ZONING.

The Prince George's County Code

(1987 Edition, 1988 Supplement, as amended by CB-68-1989).

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that Section 27-642(c) of the Zoning Ordinance of Prince George's County, Maryland, being also Subtitle 27 of the Prince George's County Code, be and the same is hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

SUBTITLE 27. ZONING.

PART 13. AREA MASTER PLANS, GENERAL PLAN, FUNCTIONAL MASTER PLANS, AND PLANNING AREAS.

DIVISION 2. PROCEDURES.

Sec. 27-642. Public and municipal participation.

(c) Citizens advisory committee

* * * * * * * * * * *

- (4) In the case of an amendment to the Historic Sites and

 Districts Plan, the nine (9) members of the Historic Preservation

 Commission, and four (4) citizens designated by the District

 Council, shall serve as the citizens advisory committee.
- (5) The citizens advisory committee shall, under the direction of the Planning Board or its designee, review, provide input, and comment on the plan in accordance with the purposes set forth in Paragraph (1) of this Subsection.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) calendar days after the date of its adoption.
