CB-002-2025 Draft 1

AN ACT CONCERNING WATERCRAFT PARKED ON COUNTY

<u>ROADS</u> for the purpose of prohibiting the parking of watercraft on public streets, roads, highways, and rights of way within the County; to establish fines and penalties for parking a personally-owned watercraft on public streets, roads, highways, and rights of way in the County; to permit the towing and impounding of any personally-owned watercraft after a certain number of violations; and generally relating to the prohibition of parking a personally-owned watercraft on public streets, roads, highways, and rights-of-way in Prince George's County.

Nathaniel Tutt, Director, Government Operations and Fiscal Policy Committee (GOFP), provided an overview of CB-002-2025. Joel Peebles, Jr., Legislative Officer, provided an overview of Proposed Draft 2 and additional amendments. Dinora Hernandez, Associate County Attorney, Office of Law, stated that the Office of Law finds the legislation to be in proper legal form and sees no legal impediments to its enactment. Sakinda Skinner, Council Liaison, Office of the County Executive, stated that the County Executive is not in support of the bill in its current form and would like time to work with the bill sponsor on possible unintended consequences and practical difficulties of enforcement. Samara Gomez, Deputy Director, Revenue Authority, provided comments. Victoria Reynolds, Lorraine Taylor, William Anthony Taylor, Sheila Sloan, Connie Boddie, Dave Reynolds, William Walmsley, and Coreen Gilbert signed up to speak. Council moved to hold this bill until the next Committee of the Whole.

A motion was made by Council Member Olson, seconded by Council Member Blegay, that this Council Bill be Held in Committee. The motion carried by the following vote:
