## BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

The Housing Initiative Partnership, Inc. (HIP), a nonprofit organization operates a program called HIP HOMES. HIP acquires dilapidated, vacant single family homes and rehabilitates these homes and sells them to first time homebuyers earning 80 percent or less of the median area income. HIP has applied to participate in the Neighborhood Partnership Program operated by the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development. The Department will set aside an allocation of tax credits for business entities that contribute to the HIP HOMES Project. Local legislative support is a requirement to participate in the Program.
