




Update on the FY 2022-2027 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) COW Presentation, May 10, 2021





PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION

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The Board Approved FY22 CIP requested a total of \$256 Million

→ Total County Funding Requested: \$210 Million

→ Total State Funding Requested: \$46 Million

Projected Funding for the FY22 CIP is \$167,530,000

→ Total OMB Recommended Funding: \$132,208,000*

*includes \$34 million in ACF funding

(\$78 million less than requested)

→ Total State Projected Funding: \$35,322,000*

*includes \$1 million in projected Aging Schools Grant funding

(\$11 million less than requested)

Major Projects in the OMB Recommended FY22 CIP include:

- \$60 Million for five (5) new schools or modernizations of existing schools; (OMB Recommendation \$22.8 M)- William Wirt MS, New Glenridge Area MS, Cherokee Lane ES Replacement, William Schmidt Center, Suitland HS,
- √ \$3 Million in Systemic Mechanical (HVAC) upgrades at existing schools;
 (OMB Recommendation \$0 M, which is included previous approved
 funds)- Charles Flowers HS HVAC
- √ \$58 Million in County-wide, county only, funded projects including, but not limited to, code compliance mandate projects, major life cycle replacement projects, security upgrades, and stadium upgrades; (OMB Recommendation \$39.7 M)
- √ 10 Million in Central Garage & Transportation projects; (OMB Recommendation \$3 M)



Other Projects in the OMB recommended FY21 CIP include:

- ✓ 8.7 Million in Staged Renovations to modernize Cycle 1 approved schools; (OMB Recommendation \$4.2 M) - Benjamin Stoddert MS, Benjamin Tasker MS, Berwyn Heights ES, Calverton ES, Longfields ES, Thomas Johnson MS
- √ 15.8 Million in design funding for one (1) neighborhood elementary school and two (2) new or modernized high schools and one (1) ECC; (OMB Recommendation \$14 M)- Cool Spring ES, New Northern HS, High Point HS, Frances Fuchs ECC
- √ 4 Million in planning and design funding for, but not limited to, a facilities condition assessment, upcoming feasibility studies, and design services for future modernizations and staged renovations; (OMB Recommendation \$4 M)
- √ 10.3 Million in Roof Replacement projects at existing schools and facilities; (OMB Recommendation \$10.4 M)

Alternative Construction Financing (ACF) - Cycle 1 **PGCPS** Schools - Package 1

Update Summary:

- All 6 "Package 1" school projects are in design.
- \$34 million will cover the progress payment, the milestone payment, and the ACF administrative costs for FY22.
- Occupancy of all 6 "Package 1" schools are scheduled for August 2023.
