**PLANNING, ZONING & ECONOMIC. DEV. COM. REPORT**

DATE: 9/15/99

Committee Vote: Favorable as amended; 5-0 (In favor: Council Members Russell, Bailey, Gourdine, Hendershot and Maloney)

Staff gave an overview of the purpose of the resolution and informed the Committee of technical amendments recommended by the Office of Law. One such amendment is on page 2, line 9 and includes inserting "adopted by" after "99-3." This amendment and the other minor technical amendments are reflected in Draft-2.

The Legislative Officer determined that the legislation is in proper legal form. The County Executive takes no position on CR-32-1999.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT**

Article 28, Section 8-112.1 of the Annotated Code of Maryland requires that certain municipal ordinances regulating residential parking, fences, and outdoor storage be approved by the District Council before the ordinance becomes effective. This is a resolution to approve amendments to the Town of Cottage City's Code. The resolution will approve the enactment of Ordinance No. 99-3, amending Section 9-7 of the Code of the Town concerning abandoned vehicles.
