Staff gave an overview of the purpose of the resolution and informed the Committee of technical amendments recommended by the Office of Law. Article 28, Section 8-112.1 of the Annotated Code of Maryland requires that certain municipal ordinances regulating residential parking, fences, and outdoor storage be approved by the District Council before the ordinance becomes effective. This is a resolution to approve amendments to the Town of Cottage City's Code. The resolution will approve the enactment of Ordinance No. 99-3, amending Section 9-7 of the Code of the Town concerning abandoned vehicles.
