WHEREAS	5, The Prince George=s County Planning Board received a request from the
Mayor of the Cit	y of Hyattsville to prepare a Mixed-Use Town Center (M-U-TC) Zoning Map
Amendment for	the City of Hyattsville; and
WHEREAS	S, Section 27-198.02 of the Zoning Ordinance provides that such a Map
Amendment may	be initiated by the Planning Board only upon concurrence (by resolution) of the
District Council;	and
WHEREAS	s, the Prince George=s County Planning Board approved staff=s request to
prepare a Mixed-	Use Town Center (M-U-TC) Zoning Map Amendment for the City of
Hyattsville, to de	termine the appropriate area for mixed-use land uses and zoning in order to
foster redevelopi	ment and revitalization in the city; and
WHEREAS	s, the Zoning Ordinance provides that the District Council may zone property to
the Mixed-Use T	own Center Zone only where an approved Master Plan recommends a Mixed-
Use Town Cente	r Zone, or where the area is demonstrated to be an older, substantially developed
mixed-use comm	unity; and
WHEREAS	s, the Approved Master Plan and Sectional Map Amendment for Planning Area
68 recommends	the M-U-TC Zone for the City of Hyattsville, which is an older, substantially
developed mixed	l-use community.

1	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George=s
2	County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington
3	Regional District in Prince George=s County, Maryland, that the Maryland-National Capital
4	Park and Planning Commission is hereby directed to prepare a M-U-TC Zoning Map
5	Amendment for the City of Hyattsville, in accordance with the requirements of the Zoning
6	Ordinance.
7	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a joint public hearing on the M-U-TC Zoning Map
8	Amendment shall be held by the Planning Board and District Council and that the provisions of
9	Section 27-198.02 mandating separate public hearings by the Planning Board and District
10	Council shall not apply in this instance.
11	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.
