#### PLANNING, ZONING & ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

**Date 9/19/2007**

Committee Vote: Favorable, 4-0 (In favor: Council Members Dean, Bland, Exum, and Harrington)

Staff explained that the resolution approves an amendment to Chapter 125 of the City of College Park Code concerning residential parking and storage. The City adopted Ordinance 07-0-12 on June 12, 2007 for the purpose of amending certain regulations for residential parking. The Ordinance reduces the time from 30 days to 15 days that vehicles which are inoperable, dismantled, wrecked or unregistered are allowed to be parked or stored on residential property. Section 8-112.1 of Article 28 of the Maryland Annotated Code requires District Council approval of the City's ordinance before it becomes effective.

The Office of Law reviewed CR-56-2007 and determined that it is in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its adoption.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:**

Section 8-112.1 of Article 28 of the Maryland Annotated Code authorizes municipalities within the Maryland-Washington Metropolitan District to enact certain ordinances, including the regulation of residential parking and storage, subject to the approval of the District Council. The proposed resolution approves the regulation of residential parking and storage enacted by the City of College Park.
