Good Morning Director Tutt,

Regarding CB-12 – the CEX **supports this legislation with Amendments**. Suggestions are:

- Graduated penalties where attendance has a less severe maximum penalty than organizing and participating. For example, if participating/organizing carries 60 days, attendance should have a maximum penalty of 30 days. Whatever the sponsor deems appropriate to match the penalty to the conduct.
- On **page 2 lines 27-29** align penalty with criminal code section 10-202 which allows local jurisdiction to implement a term of incarceration no more than 6 months. The Administration recommends changing the maximum penalty from 12 months to 6 months.
