RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Super Bowl XLII (2008) - Vending

3 For the purpose of prohibiting all temporary vendor licensing during the Super Bowl Period for
 4 the area within a two and nine-tenth mile radius of the Stadium property boundaries, and
 5 restricting the issuance of new or expanded vending permits or licenses during the Super Bowl
 6 Period, contingent upon a successful bid by the Washington, D.C. Super Bowl Host Committee
 7 for Super Bowl XLII (2008).

8 WHEREAS, the National Football League (the “League”) owns, produces and controls the
 9 annual professional football championship game known as the “Super Bowl”, the largest national
 10 annual sporting event held in this country; and National Football League Properties, LLC
 11 (“NFLP” or, together with the League, the “NFL”) owns, produces and controls the “NFL
 12 Experience,” and along with other NFL Affiliates, owns, produces and controls certain other
 13 events associated with the Super Bowl (“Official Events”); and

14 WHEREAS, "Super Bowl Period" shall commence ten days prior to game day and shall
 15 terminate 48 hours after the conclusion of the Super Bowl Game itself; and

16 WHEREAS, Prince George's County, Maryland is desirous of hosting Super Bowl XLII
 17 (2008) and its related Official Events.

18 SECTION 1. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince
 19 George's County, Maryland, that as requested by the NFL, and as part of the formal bid of the
 20 Washington, D.C. Super Bowl Host Committee, with Prince George’s County, Maryland to be
 21 designated as the site for Super Bowl XLII (2008) and related Official Events, with the Stadium
 22 and related facilities located in Prince George's County, Maryland, the governing body of Prince

1 George's County, Maryland declares as follows:

2 1. Upon designation of Prince George's County, Maryland as the site for Super Bowl
3 XLII (2008) and related Official Events, with the Stadium and related facilities located in Prince
4 George's County, Maryland, and at all times thereafter, Prince George's County, Maryland agrees
5 to prohibit all temporary vendor licensing during the Super Bowl Period for the area within a two
6 and nine-tenth mile radius of the Stadium property boundaries, described in Attachment 1,
7 attached hereto and made a part hereof.

8 2. Upon designation of Prince George's County, Maryland as the site for Super Bowl
9 XLII (2008) and related Official Events, with the Stadium and related facilities located in Prince
10 George's County, Maryland, and at all times thereafter, Prince George's County, Maryland agrees
11 to restrict the issuance of new or expanded vending permits or licenses during the Super Bowl
12 Period.

13 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect upon
14 the date of adoption and that Section 1 of this Resolution shall take effect upon the date of
15 receipt of a successful bid by the Washington, D.C. Super Bowl Host Committee for Super Bowl
16 XLII (2008). In the event that the designation of Prince George's County, Maryland as the site
17 for Super Bowl XLII (2008) and related Official Events, with the Stadium and related facilities
18 located in Prince George's County, Maryland does not occur, the provisions of this Resolution
19 shall be deemed null and void and of no further force and effect.
