RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

Super Bowl XLII (2008) - Vending

For the purpose of prohibiting all temporary vendor licensing during the Super Bowl Period for the area within a two and nine-tenth mile radius of the Stadium property boundaries, and restricting the issuance of new or expanded vending permits or licenses during the Super Bowl Period, contingent upon a successful bid by the Washington, D.C. Super Bowl Host Committee for Super Bowl XLII (2008).

WHEREAS, the National Football League (the "League") owns, produces and controls the annual professional football championship game known as the "Super Bowl", the largest national annual sporting event held in this country; and National Football League Properties, LLC ("NFLP" or, together with the League, the "NFL") owns, produces and controls the "NFL Experience," and along with other NFL Affiliates, owns, produces and controls certain other events associated with the Super Bowl ("Official Events"); and

WHEREAS, "Super Bowl Period" shall commence ten days prior to game day and shall terminate 48 hours after the conclusion of the Super Bowl Game itself; and

WHEREAS, Prince George's County, Maryland is desirous of hosting Super Bowl XLII (2008) and its related Official Events.

SECTION 1. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that as requested by the NFL, and as part of the formal bid of the Washington, D.C. Super Bowl Host Committee, with Prince George's County, Maryland to be designated as the site for Super Bowl XLII (2008) and related Official Events, with the Stadium and related facilities located in Prince George's County, Maryland, the governing body of Prince

George's County, Maryland declares as follows:

- 1. Upon designation of Prince George's County, Maryland as the site for Super Bowl XLII (2008) and related Official Events, with the Stadium and related facilities located in Prince George's County, Maryland, and at all times thereafter, Prince George's County, Maryland agrees to prohibit all temporary vendor licensing during the Super Bowl Period for the area within a two and nine-tenth mile radius of the Stadium property boundaries, described in Attachment 1, attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- 2. Upon designation of Prince George's County, Maryland as the site for Super Bowl XLII (2008) and related Official Events, with the Stadium and related facilities located in Prince George's County, Maryland, and at all times thereafter, Prince George's County, Maryland agrees to restrict the issuance of new or expanded vending permits or licenses during the Super Bowl Period.
- SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect upon the date of adoption and that Section 1 of this Resolution shall take effect upon the date of receipt of a successful bid by the Washington, D.C. Super Bowl Host Committee for Super Bowl XLII (2008). In the event that the designation of Prince George's County, Maryland as the site for Super Bowl XLII (2008) and related Official Events, with the Stadium and related facilities located in Prince George's County, Maryland does not occur, the provisions of this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and of no further force and effect.
