**BILL**

AN ACT concerning

The Methane Gas Power System Internal Service Fund  
FOR the purpose of dissolving the Methane Gas Power System  
Internal Service Fund and transferring the assets,  
liabilities, and retained earnings of that fund to the  
Environmental and Recycling Enterprise Fund.

BY repealing:

SUBTITLE 10. FINANCE AND TAXATION  
Sections 10-260,  
The Prince George's County Code  
(1991 Edition).

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that Section 10-260 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby repealed:

**SUBTITLE 10. FINANCE AND TAXATION.**

**DIVISION 10. ENTERPRISE AND OTHER SPECIAL PURPOSE FUNDS.**

**Section 10-260. [Methane Gas Power System Internal Service Fund; establishment.] Reserved.**

[(a) There is hereby established and created an internal service fund to be known as the "Methane Gas Power System Internal Service Fund." It shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of this Section and Section 10-248.05.

(b) The purpose of this Fund shall be to finance the costs associated with the development, administration and operation of the methane gas power system for the processing of methane gas collected from the Brown Station Road Sanitary Landfill to generate electricity and power boilers at the Correctional Center and the Upper Marlboro Complex.]

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that all assets, liabilities, and retained earnings related to the Methane Gas Power System Internal Service Fund shall be transferred to the

Environmental and Recycling Enterprise Fund as of June 30, 1992.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the requirement for reimbursement of \$2,500,000 expended from the Land Reclamation Enterprise Funds in CR-2-1985 be forgiven and the same is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law and shall be retroactively effective to June 30, 1992.
