**RESOLUTION**

A RESOLUTION concerning

State of Maryland Community Investment Tax Credit Program

For the purpose of approving the project submitted by the Housing Initiative Partnership, Inc. (“HIP”) to the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development for participation in the Department’s Community Investment Tax Credit Program.

WHEREAS, Section 6-401 through Section 6-406 of the Housing and Community Development Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, established the Neighborhood and Community Assistance Program to assist nonprofit organizations in carrying out approved projects in designated revitalization areas, to encourage businesses to invest in priority funding areas, and to strengthen public-private partnerships; and

WHEREAS, Section 6-404 of the Housing and Community Development Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, provides for the allocation of tax credits to business entities that contribute to approved projects of nonprofit organizations that provide services to priority funding areas; and

WHEREAS, Section 6-405(c) of the Housing and Community Development Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, provides that the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development may not approve a proposal for participation in the Neighborhood and Community Assistance Program (“Program”) unless the proposal is approved by the governing body of the county that includes any of the Priority Funding Area that benefits from the project; and

WHEREAS, HIP, a nonprofit organization in Prince George’s County, proposes to expand “Bounce Back”, a financial literacy program, more particularly described in Attachment A (the

“Project”) to serve pre-purchase clients and renters as well as its foreclosure prevention clients;  
and

WHEREAS, HIP will apply to the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development for approval of the Project and an allocation of tax credits in the amount of \$20,000 for business entities that contribute to the Project pursuant to the Department’s Community Investment Tax Credit Program; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive expresses approval of the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, hereby expresses continued approval of the Project, as set forth in Attachment A, submitted by HIP to the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development for participation in the Community Investment Tax Credit Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this Resolution shall be sent by the Clerk of the Council to the County Executive, Housing Initiative Partnership, Inc. and the Secretary of the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development.

Housing Initiative Partnership, Inc.’s office is located in COUNCILMANIC DISTRICT 2.

**APPLICANT:** The Housing Initiative Partnership, Inc. (HIP), is a non-profit organization in the State of Maryland, that is an innovative, green nonprofit developer based in Prince George’s County, Maryland dedicated to revitalizing neighborhoods and removing blight. HIP creates housing and economic opportunities for persons of low- and moderate-income and provides services that improve the quality of life in the communities served.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The program’s name is “Bounce Back” an innovative financial literacy program targeted to homeowners who have received loan modifications or emergency assistance on their mortgages. “Bounce Back” provides a combination of monthly workshops and one-on-one counseling to increase the financial literacy of participants, create budgets and develop long-term financial goal to change their financial management practices. The “Bounce Back” program serves all residents of Prince George’s, particularly within the 21 zip codes considered foreclosure “hot spots” by the State. An award of CITCs will be used pay a portion of the personnel costs of the “Bounce Back” Program Administrator in order to expand the “Bounce Back” program to serve pre-purchase clients interested in buying homes and renters at HIP-owned properties in addition to HIP’s foreclosure prevention clients living within Priority Funding Areas within the County. HIP also will enroll at least 35 clients in “My Budget Coach”, a pilot online budget tracking and coaching system managed by Maryland Cash Campaign.
