BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 County Employee Health Insurance

3 For the purpose of requiring that any health insurer contracted to offer health insurance plans to
4 County employees includes at least one health insurance plan with an inpatient hospital located
5 in Prince George's County in its coverage network.

6 BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

7 SUBTITLE 16. PERSONNEL.

8 Section 16-212,

9 The Prince George's County Code

10 (2015 Edition; 2016 Supplement).

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
12 Maryland, that Section 16-212 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby
13 repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

14 SUBTITLE 16. PERSONNEL.

15 DIVISION 15. DEVELOPMENT AND INCENTIVES.

16 **Sec. 16-212. - Health and life insurance plans.**

17 The County Executive shall establish health and life insurance plans for the benefit of all
18 permanent status employees. Said plans may provide for contributions by both the County and
19 participating employees toward the cost of maintaining said plans. The benefits established under
20 said plans, as well as any County contributions thereto, may be increased from time to time by
21 the County Executive, but said benefits and/or contributions shall not be decreased by the

1 County Executive without the prior approval of the County Council by resolution or by a specific
2 reduction of the amount of funds budgeted for said purposes. Any insurer contracted with or
3 procured by the County to provide health insurance to employees shall offer at least one health
4 insurance plan to employees that includes a hospital that both provides inpatient hospital services
5 and is located in Prince George’s County in the health insurance plan’s coverage network.

6 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)
7 calendar days after it becomes law.
