Department Name: Orphans' Court



Mission

• provides supervision of decedents' estates and children's property to the beneficiaries in order to protect decedents' and children's assets

Core Services

To monitor the property of a deceased resident of the County in order to carry out the wishes of the decedent and to ensure distribution to the beneficiaries

To provide protection of children's assets until they are legally adults (18 years of age) in order to ensure proper monetary distribution for their short term and long term needs

Strategic Focus FY 2026

Increase the number of decedents' assets that are intact through having one sitting judge review caseload and dockets.

Increase the number of guardianships with assets intact through having one sitting judge review caseload and dockets.

Provide residents the opportunity for mediation, and/or collaborative process and settlement conferences in resolving probate matters through the Orphans' Courts ADR program.



VACANCY

As of March 13, 2025, 6 out of 8 General Fund authorized Full-Time Civilian positions were filled

- -As of March 13, 2025, 2 full-time civilian positions were reported as vacant, representing a 25% vacancy rate
- -The (2) vacant positions are the Law Clerk I (which has been vacant for several fiscal years now due to funding) and Community Developer I positions.

Currently, the Court continues to review cases for Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR)

ADR program has been without funding and staffing for the ADR position

- **1**,198 estate cases have been closed in FY 2025

 - **●**13,017 estate cases have been opened
 - **●**8,079 have been closed

- **©**31 guardianship cases are open
- **©**41 guardianship cases have been closed in FY 2025
- **©**From FY 2022 FY 2025 (YTD)
 - **©**184 guardianship cases have been opened
 - ©202 have been closed


