#### AN ACT CONCERNING FISCAL RESPONSIBILITY AND GOOD

**GOVERNMENT** for the purpose of requiring the Director of the Office of Management and Budget to submit a statement to the Council describing the fiscal impact of each bill before Council action; specifying the contents of the fiscal impact statement; and generally amending the law governing the consideration of bills by the County Council.
